

Fine Policy

Flixton Juniors believes that fining grassroots activities can be at odds with the desire to be inclusive, especially for families who are financially disadvantaged.

Flixton Juniors also supports disciplinary action, including fining, for poor behaviour on and off the field of play, including failure to comply with necessary safeguarding measures.

Fines from England Football or leagues or other footballing bodies are levied against the Club on behalf of Coaches, Teams or Players.

Where a fine is levied against a Coach, Team or Player, the Club will recharge the Coach, Team or Player for the fine levied, except in cases where a Player is in a Team registered as Under 16 or younger (“Junior Player”).

Where a Junior Player receives their first caution fine in a season, the Club will cover the fine levied by the FA.

However, should the same Junior Player receive further fines for cautions in the same season, then the Club will fine the parents of the Player £25 on each instance.

Should a Junior Player receive a fine for a dismissal, the Club will fine the parents of the Player the full levied fine from the FA. Such Junior Players will be subsequently fined £25 for each caution, even if they had not yet been cautioned this season.
